

Ground Rules for Comox Valley Slo-Pitch Leagues

Highland#1.....Any fly ball, rolling ball or bounced ball that enters the sand pit in center-right field will be ruled a ground rule double. Even if the ball is first played on before entering the sand it will be ruled a ground rule double when it enters the sand.

If the ball is a hit fly ball and it passes completely over the sand while in the air and hits the ground beyond the sand pit it shall be ruled a home run.

Highland #2.....Same rule for sand pit.

If the ball is hit into or bounces into the concession building or any tables or furniture used around the building it will be ruled a ground rule double. If the ball passes over the building in the air and lands completely beyond the building it will be ruled a home run. If there is any doubt about what occurred it will be ruled a ground rule double.

Valleyview #1.....A ball that flies into, rolls into or bounces into or under the portable building in left field will be ruled a ground rule double. If the ball passes over the building on the fly and lands beyond the building it shall be ruled a home run.

A ball that rolls or bounces over the mound beyond center field will be ruled a ground rule double. If a hit ball carries over the hill on the fly and lands beyond the hill, it shall be ruled a home run.

Valleyview #3..... A ball that rolls, bounces, or flies into the woods in center right field shall be ruled a ground rule double.

Lewis #2.....The tree in left field presents a problem. Therefore any ball that flies through the tree or flies past the left side of the tree shall be ruled a ground rule double. If the ball rolls into or bounces into the tree and actually strikes the tree anywhere, it shall be ruled a ground rule double.
